Key competences and experiences

Wine sales and staff training. Very experienced in communication with customers on the shop floor; developed and implemented guidelines for shop floor communication, implemented a staff training program for wine sales (both in *Vinifera retail store* and *Prime Minister Wine and Spirits*).

Sales personalization in wine retail. Developed (Python/Django) a CRM system for arbitrary segmentation of audience for specific selling propositions based on the variety of criteria. The CRM also provided an opportunity to quantify customer relations by introducing various KPIs.

Assortment management in a wine store. Implemented a policy for the consistent use of wine ratings. Developed and implemented software for the management of shelftalkers and wine ratings in retail. Created guidelines for assortment selection based on the consistent use of wine ratings, value to price ratio, obscure varieties and appellations—every bottle should have its unique selling proposition.

Wine writing. Published a number of articles on wine since 2014 on the website *grozdi.ru* in Russian (under a pen name V. Aristov). In the circumstances of Russia's alcohol advertising ban, the social media and email marketing for *Vinifera* were also extremely demanding for informative yet entertaining tasting notes and captivating narratives. In wine writing tries to convey the value by providing tangible details from the enological perspective as well as vivid yet accurate metaphors—without vague platitudes and senseless clichés.

Conducting wine tastings. Since 2014 led about one hundred wine tastings for different audiences at various venues. Also conducted multiple wine tasting in English in Stanford Wine Society.

Wine evaluation. Using the experience of tasting wines with known reputable ratings and tasting notes as a reference, described and rated wines at technical tastings of samples for possible procurement, at wine exhibitions and industry events. Took part in the jury of the UVWR Cup 2018, the red wines section.
